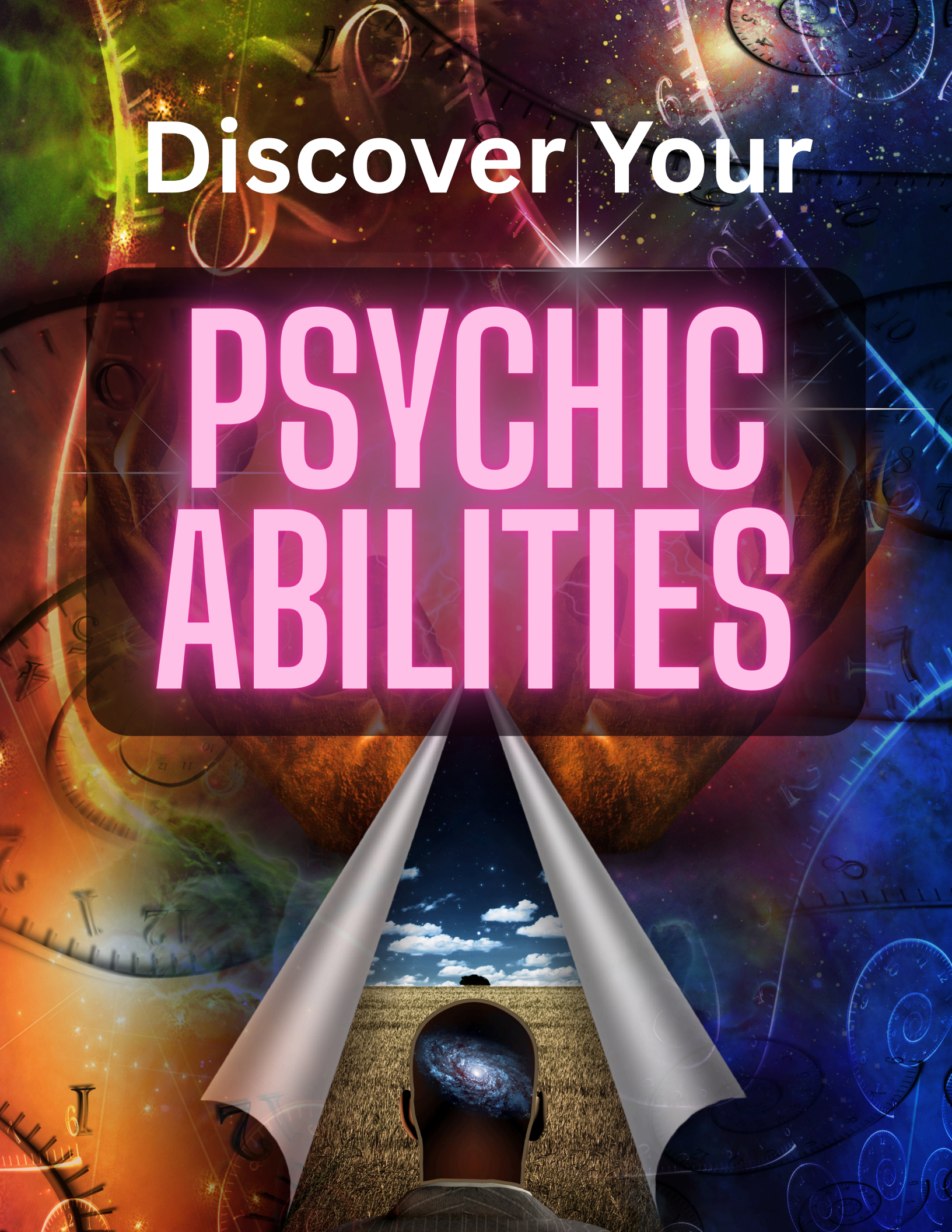

## Discover Your Natural Abilities

Before answering each question, close your eyes, take a deep breath and use your mind to retrieve the answer. Notice what comes to you first, no matter what form it takes. That is your primary answer. Mark that with an X. Then notice if any other information comes to you. Those are your secondary answers. Rank those from 1 to 4 in accordance to their strength, with 4 being the weakest.

### **Calculate your Answers**

Add up all the letters you marked with an X, the most often occurring letter is your primary clair. The others are your secondary clairs ranked according to strength. Don't worry if there is not one stronger than the other, that just means that you have equal strength in all of them!

#### **Mostly A's**

Your primary clair is Clairvoyance which means you have Spiritual Sight. You can 'see' the past, present or future. You usually see images very strongly in your mind's eye. Your dreams are unusually vivid.

#### **Mostly B's**

Your primary clair is Clairsentience which means you have Spiritual Sensing. You can 'feel' or 'sense' the past, present or future. You usually feel other people's emotions very strongly. You are often quite sensitive and empathic. Your body reacts when you are nervous, often resulting in physical illness or exhaustion when bombarded by too many people's energies.

#### **Mostly C's**

Your primary clair is Claircognizant which means you have Spiritual Knowing. You often have strong knowledge of events of the past, present and future. You are often quite intellectual. You are often exceedingly curious about history, other cultures and learning new things which involve lateral and intellectual thinking.

#### **Mostly D's**

Your primary clair is Clairaudience which means you have Spiritual Hearing. You 'hear' information in your mind's ear and will often hear sounds, music, words and messages about the past, present and future. You are sensitive to sound, passionate about music, and you can sometimes have reduced hearing in normal situations.

#### **Mostly E's**

Your primary clair is Clairgustance/Clairalience which means you have Spiritual Taste and Smell. These two often go together. You can 'taste/smell' information in your mind and will often detect flavors or scents associated with a person, event or location. You are sensitive to fragrances, flavors and aromas and most likely enjoy cooking!
